AUTO/DIESEL SERVICE

Prepares students in the diagnosis and repair of brakes, electrical systems, engine performance, and suspension and steering.

CONCURRENT

FOR ALL HIGH SCHOOL AGES

Choose from a variety of college courses and earn your degree early!

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Any high school student may enroll in college courses if they have a 2.5 GPA and qualifying test scores.
- If a 9th grade student would like to enroll, they may pay \$125 per class, but will not be eligible for the concurrent scholarship until the 10th grade.

CONCURRENT SCHOLARSHIP

- Allows sophomores, juniors, and seniors to take 2 classes per semester for F R E E.
- If a student would like to enroll in more than 2 classes per semester, they may pay \$125 per additional class.

ELIGIBILITY Must be in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade | Must have a 2.5 GPA or higher
